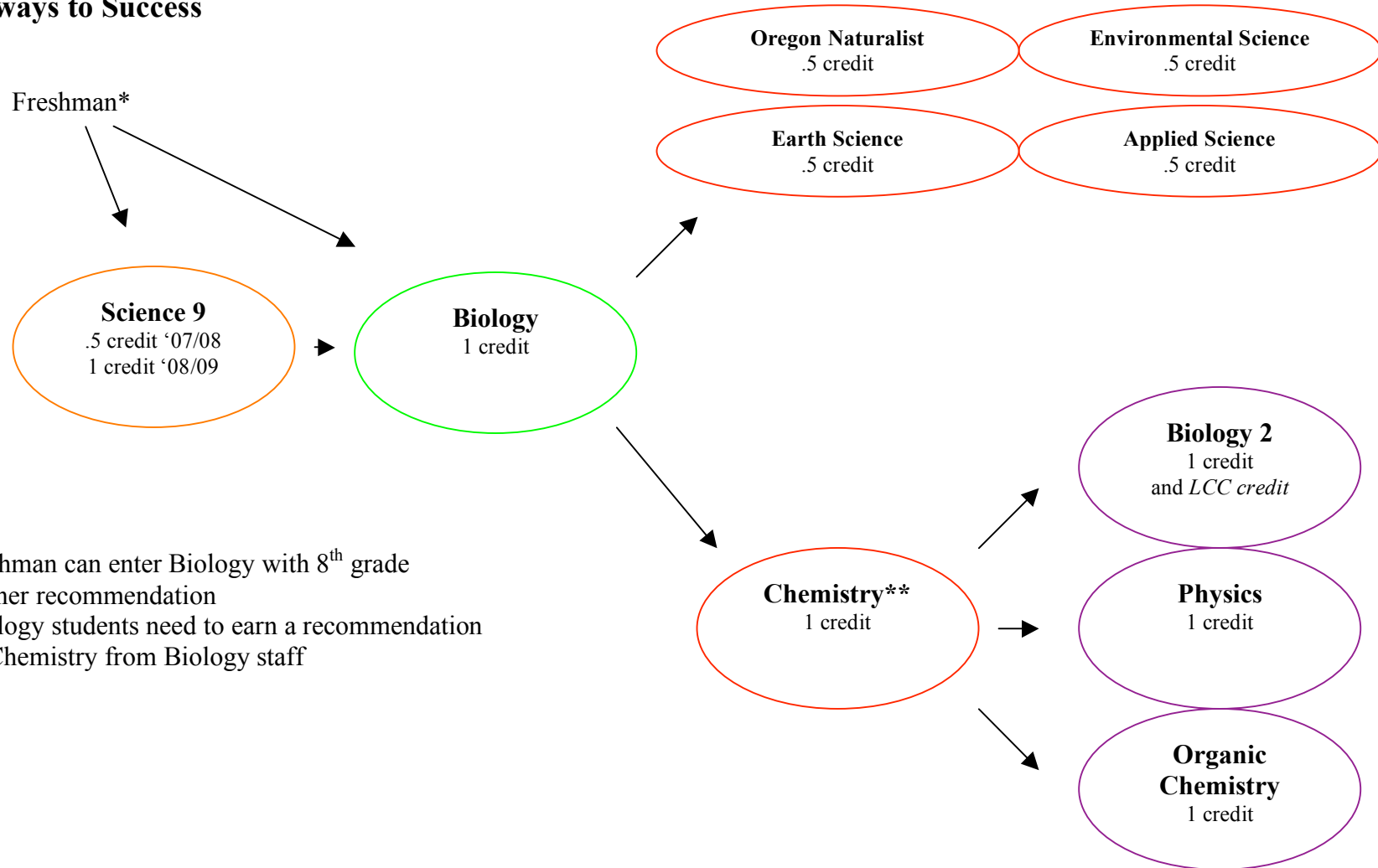

\*\*Biology students need to earn a recommendation to Chemistry from Biology staff

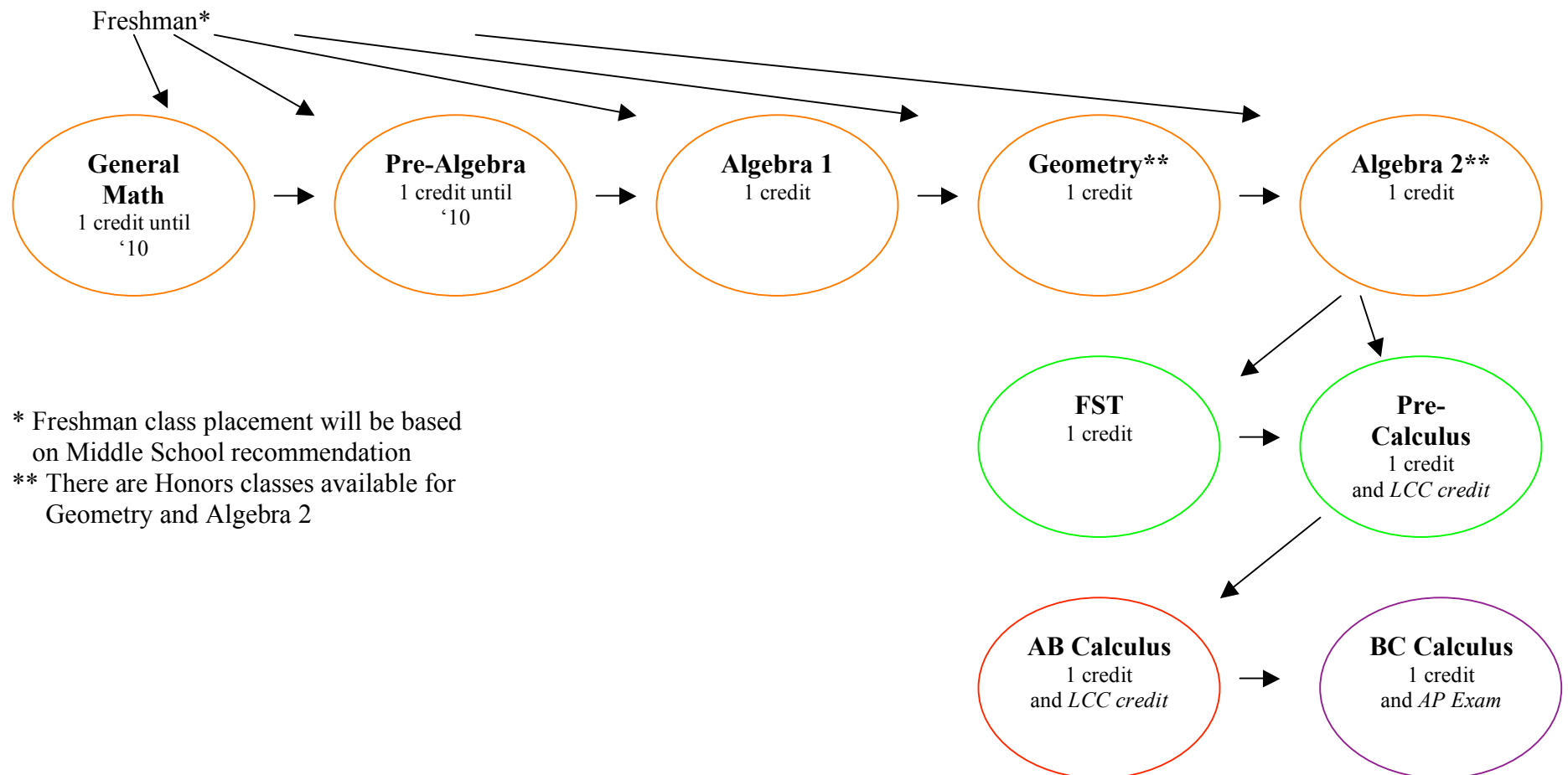

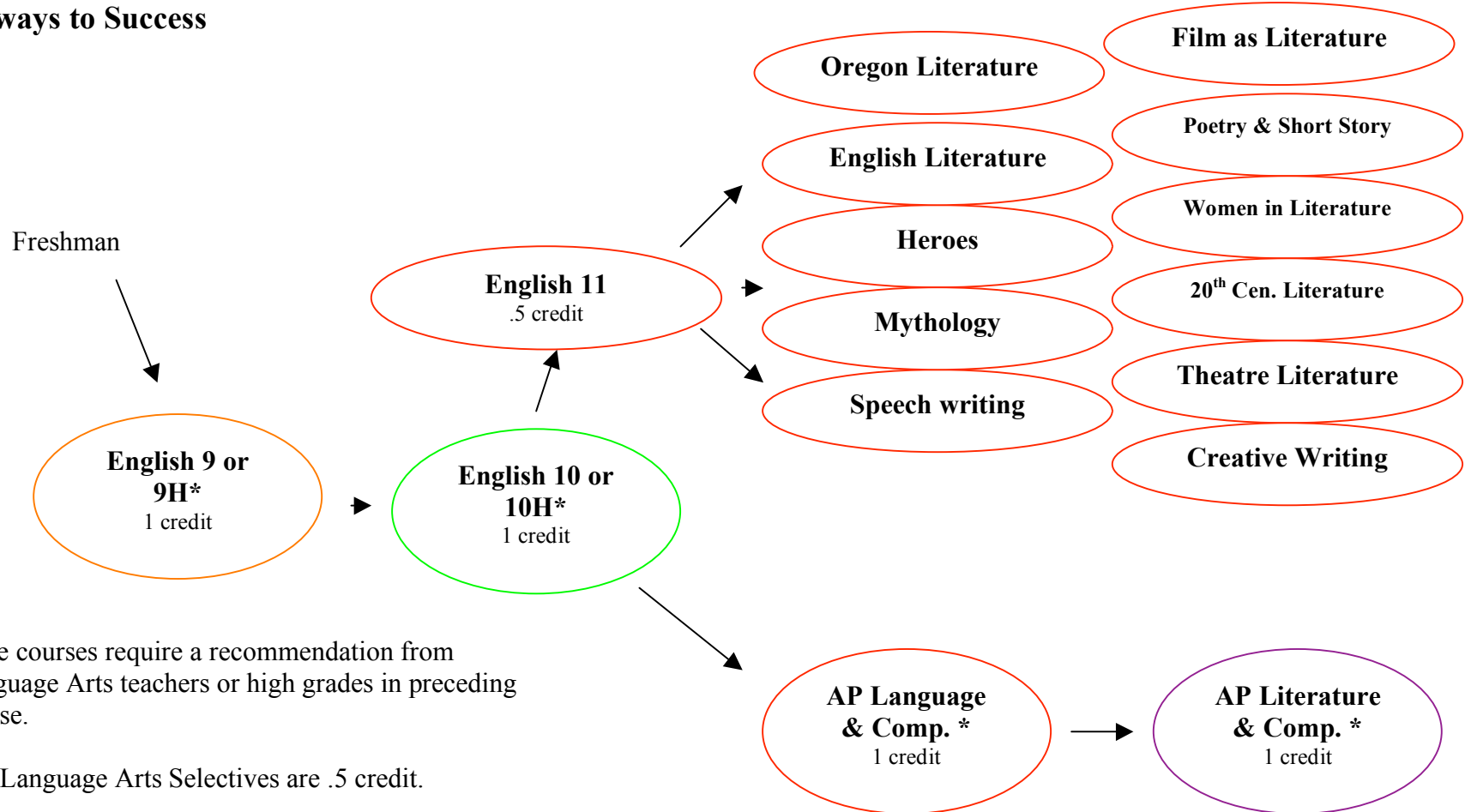
# Language Arts

\*These courses require a recommendation from Language Arts teachers or high grades in preceding course.

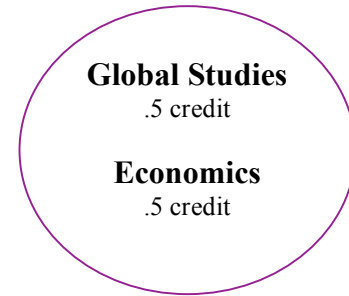
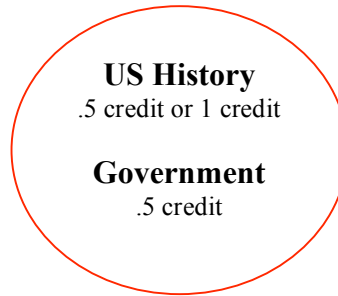
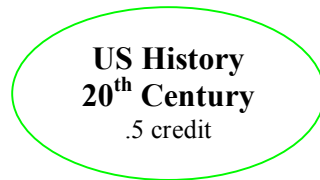
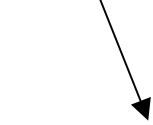
